Dear Mr. [REDACTED]:

We had reduced your monetary compensation beginning 10/06/2002 because we began to pay you based on a Wage-earning capacity. By decision dated 5/20/2005, the Employees' Compensation Appeals Board (ECAB) reversed our prior determination. Therefore, based on the ECAB decision, we are paying you additional monetary compensation for total disability beginning 10/06/2002.

You were paid \$5,564.96 for the period 10/06/2002 through 10/01/2005. Because you should have been paid \$61,579.57 for this period, you were underpaid \$56,014.61. A payment of \$56,014.61 will be deposited to your checking account shortly. This represents the additional amount of compensation you are due for the period 10/06/2002 through 10/01/2005. Beginning 10/02/2005, you began receiving ongoing monetary compensation for total disability.
